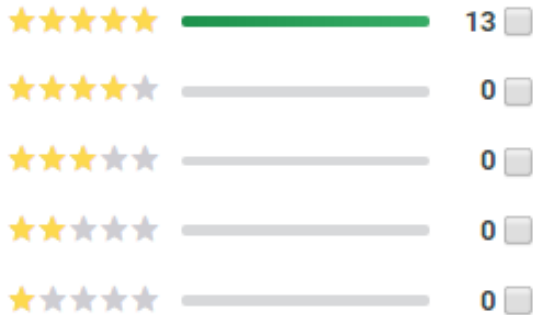

We have been meeting for a "get-away" almost every year for over 40 years. This was our second time to stay in this home, and we will no doubt be returning! The home is well equipped, comfortably furnished, and has stunning views overlooking the ocean with Morro Rock in the distance. It is on a bluff, on the north end of town. Cayucos is such a charming little town, and we all fell in love with it ages ago.

This home sleeps 6 adults in 3 bedrooms, has a comfortable living area, and a large, well equipped kitchen. There is a BBQ, which we did not use, and a lovely outdoor deck and small lawn. It is in a quiet area, on a bluff overlooking the sea. You can hear the ocean, and the sounds of sea lions barking and sea birds calling—very mood enhancing!! It is an easy walk into town, and there are many acres of bluffs to explore. The neighborhood is quiet—it is NOT a "party" house—which is just what we wanted.
